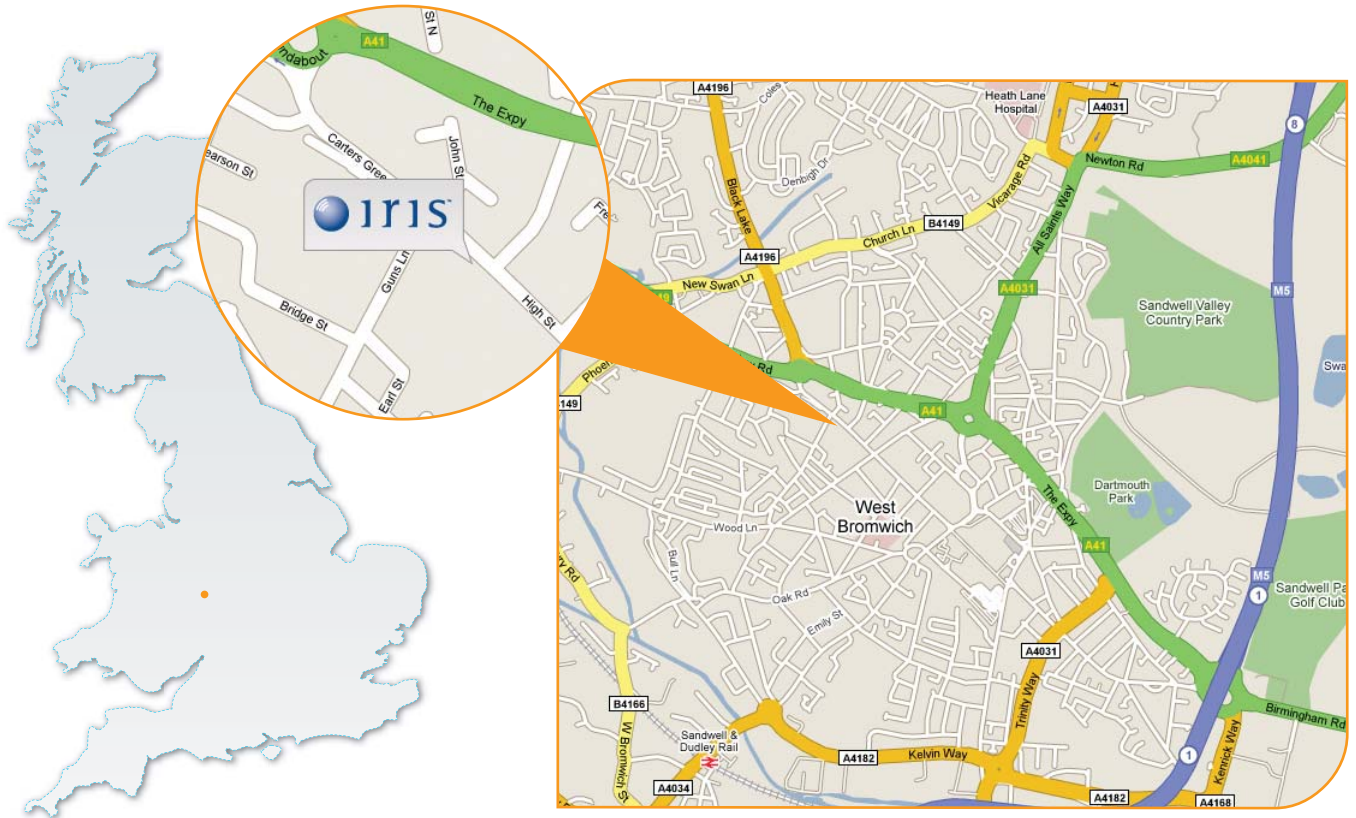

### By Road (SatNav - B70 9LD)

#### Directions from the North or the South

Leave the M5 at Junction 1 (signposted to West Bromwich A41).  
Join the A41 (The Expressway) for Dudley and Wolverhampton.

Proceed to the second roundabout (Albion Roundabout), Staples on right, Peugeot Dealer on left. Take the first left onto High Street. Kingston House is on the right-hand side after the second pelican crossing, directly opposite the Wheatsheaf public house.

#### From Birmingham

Leave Birmingham on the A41, following signs for the A41 west Bromwich. At the roundabout over Junction 1 of the M5, continue over, remaining on the A41. Follow instructions above (from the north or south).

### By Rail

The main station for visiting West Bromwich is Birmingham New Street. This can be accessed by rail from most major cities and from Birmingham International Airport. To get to West Bromwich from New Street, you need to use the Metro rail system. To pick up the Metro, you need to walk from New Street to Birmingham Snow Hill station, 5 minutes away.

From New Street you should leave the station via the escalators going up to the Pallasades shopping centre. At the top of the escalator, turn left and follow the passage way around, walking out onto the ramp (you will pass Woolworths and McDonalds on your right).

From the bottom of the ramp walk straight onto Corporation Street and then take a left down the walkway at the entrance to House of Fraser, past the Cathedral and you will see Snow Hill station over to the right. At Snow Hill, take the Metro to Dartmouth Street Station in West Bromwich.

On exiting Dartmouth Street Station, you enter Richard Street. Turn left and walk to Dartmouth Street, the first Junction. Turn left again along Dartmouth Street and continue ahead until you reach the junction with High Street. Turn left along High Street and Kingston House is on the left opposite the Wheatsheaf pub.

### By Air

The nearest airport is Birmingham International. If using a hire car, please follow the directions below.

There is a large roundabout at the exit to the airport. From this roundabout, take exit 1 onto the A45 (Coventry Road). After 1/2 mile, leave the A45, joining the M42 North at Junction 6 (signposted Tamworth and M6). After 2 miles, leave the M42 at Junction 7, joining the M6 (Birmingham, the North-West). After 13 miles, leave the M6 at Junction 8 (M5). Follow instructions opposite (from the north or south).

### On arriving at Kingston House

There is a car park to the rear of Kingston House, with several spaces reserved for visitors. The car park is protected by a barrier that requires an electronic card for entry. Follow the instructions below to gain access to the car park. Turn up the access road at the side of Kingston House. Pull onto the 'up' ramp on your right, call our reception on **0121 601 1000**, and we will trigger the barrier.

IRIS visitor spaces are located on the left immediately at the top of the ramp. Access to Kingston House is through the blue door on the same level as the car park. Again, this requires an electronic card for entry. Calling reception, as above, will ensure that someone will open this door for you and escort you to reception on the 5th floor.

**Additional parking (pay & display) is available behind the Marksman pub, 30 yards back along High Street from Kingston House on the right.**
