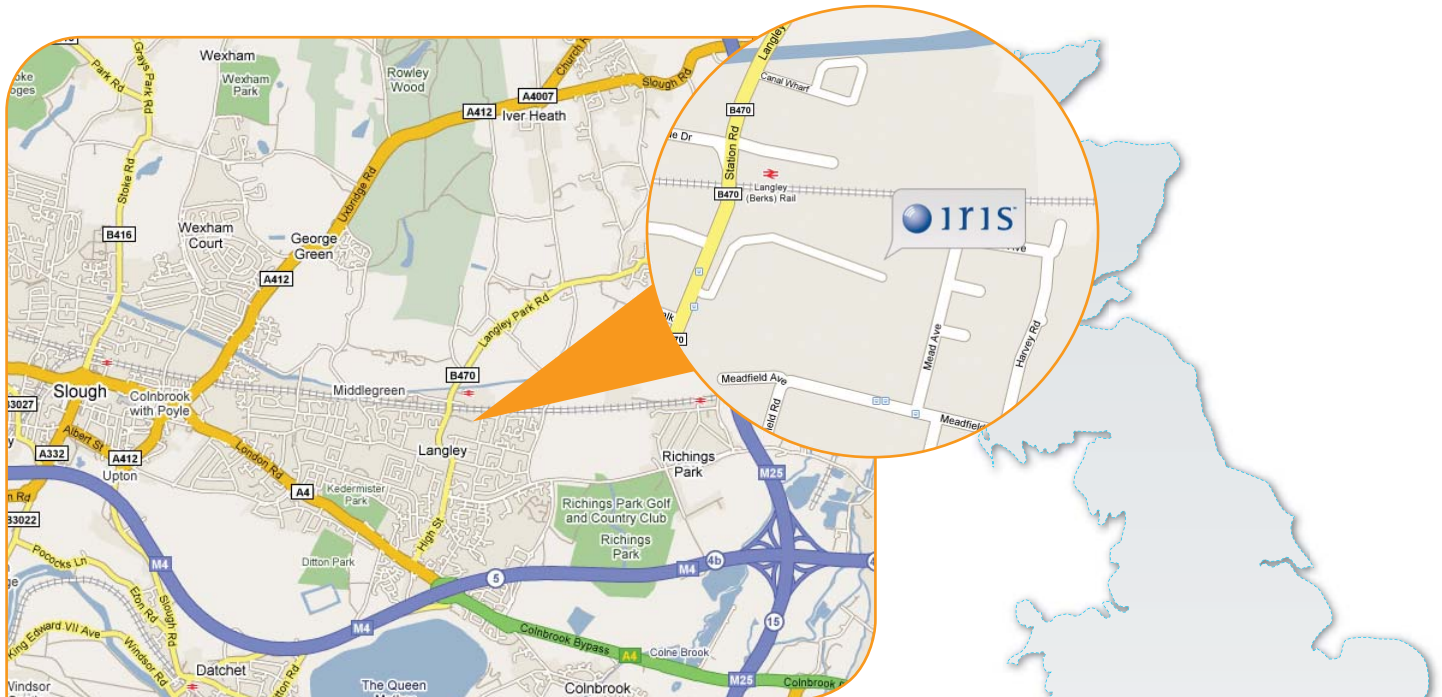


## Transoft - Langley

### By Road (SatNav - SL3 8DS)

#### Directions from the M40

- Exit the M40 at junction 1 (Denham turnoff)
- The roundabout under the motorway is two-directional; take the exit for Iver/Slough - A412 Go approx 1.5 miles to mini roundabout, take 2nd exit signposted Slough - A412 At next mini roundabout (immediate) take 1st exist - A412
- Go to next roundabout - Crooked Billet pub opposite - take 2nd exit - Wood Lane
- Go to next roundabout and take 2nd exit - B470 to Langley
- Go approx 1.5 miles over canal bridge, through traffic lights and under railway bridge
- Langley Business Centre is 100yds on the left
- When you reach the Business Centre, turn left and follow the road to the end and you will reach Transoft House

#### Directions from the M4

- Exit the M4 at Junction 5
- At the roundabout take the exit marked Slough/Langley A4
- At the next set of traffic lights turn right (at the lights the Marriott Hotel will be on the left and the King William Hotel on the right)
- Follow this road through several sets of traffic lights
- The road will bear to the left and bring you to a mini roundabout
- Go right into Station Road
- The Langley Business Centre is on the right, just after the college on the left
- If you go past the Willow Tree pub and under the bridge you have gone too far
- When you enter the Business Centre, turn left and follow the road to the end and you will reach Transoft House

### By Rail

- Take the train from British Rail, Paddington, London
- If you alight at Slough Station take a taxi to our offices (approx 10 minutes drive)
- If you alight at Langley Station come out and turn left, walk down the hill and the Business Centre will be on your left. Once in the Centre, follow the road to the end and you will reach Transoft House (approx 10 minutes walk)
